

**NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF MODERN LANGUAGES
DRESS CODE**

1. Shorts/ Bermuda/ skirts are not allowed.
2. Wearing Leggings/Tights, see-through or revealing garments, backless dresses, skinny fitted clothes are strictly prohibited.
3. Deep Neck shirts, V-Neck T-Shirts / Shirts without collar and sleeveless shirts for girls are not permitted.
4. Dress bearing languages or art which appears to be provocative or indecent and is likely to offend others is forbidden.
5. Wearing shabby or torn clothing like distressed jean (torn jeans) is not allowed.
6. During University academic hours, roaming in jogging or exercise clothing by boarders is not permitted.
7. Putting on excessive makeup or wearing expensive jewelry is prohibited.
8. Wearing untidy, gaudy or immodest dress in classrooms, cafeteria and university premises/ offices is forbidden.
9. Wearing unprofessional attire at formal occasions, events and interviews is not allowed.
10. Clothing with derogatory, offensive and/or lewd messages either in words or pictures, or any piece of clothing promoting racism, violence, sex, drugs, alcohol, or other illegal activities are not allowed.
11. Casual footwear (e.g. flip flops/ bedroom chappals, strapless chappals), high heels are not allowed including back strap open.
