DRAFT SOP – MERIT SCHOLARSHIP ON ADMISSION

- a. Applicants holding positions at Board / University level in their last degree (required for admission at NUML) are eligible to apply for Merit Scholarship as under:-
 - (1) Applicants of Undergraduate programmes. First 10 positions of the BISEs (FA / FSc).
 - (2) Applicants of Graduate programmes. First 05 positions of the Public Sector University (BA / BSc).
- b. Candidate applying for scholarship will have to provide the certificate (in original) regarding his / her position from the concerned Board / University as a proof, which will be verified from the concerned Board / University by the NUML Exams Branch.
- c. Scholarship will cover the following:-
 - (1) 1st semester. 100% waiver of tuition fee.
 - (2) 2nd and subsequent semesters. 100% waiver of tuition fee subject to maintaining following CGPA in each semester (appended CGPAs are liable to be re-fixed by university authorities from time to time):-
 - (a) Students of Management and Engg & CS programmes – minimum CGPA 3.8
 - (b) Students of Social Sciences and Languages programmes – minimum CGPA 3.6(If the student fails to maintain his / her required CGPA, he / she will be ineligible for scholarship in that particular semester).
 - (3) Student qualifying for Merit Scholarship will generally not be considered for any other University scholarship.
 - (4) If a student fails to maintain required CGPA for Merit Scholarship, then he / she may be considered for University scholarship in that particular semester fulfilling all related conditions.
- d. Other Eligibility Conditions.
 - (1) 80% mandatory cumulative attendance in the whole semester.
 - (2) There should not be any case of violation of discipline by the concerned student.
 - (3) In case a student is dropped in any course / semester, Merit Scholarship will be ceased.
- e. This SOP will be effective from the session Spring 2015. The students who are already enrolled (till session Fall 2014) are not eligible for Merit Scholarship. This SOP applies to all students applying for admission in NUML Main and Regional Campuses.
