



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF MODERN LANGUAGES

AND

THE DIABETES CENTRE

National University of Modern Languages (NUML), Khayaban-e-Johar, Sector H-9/4, Islamabad is one of the leading universities in Pakistan, is contributing in creating knowledge with a local and global perspective. It is teaching 27 oriental and occidental languages in addition to providing education in five different faculties: Faculty of languages, English Studies, Social Sciences, Management Sciences, Engineering and Computer Sciences. In all these fields, NUML is also committed to play a major role in research, development and community enhancement.

And

The Diabetes Centre (TDC) is a not-for-profit organization and Pakistan's first fully dedicated state of the art hospital that treats diabetes and all its related complications under one roof, irrespective of their ability to pay. TDC has a training and development department, a full-fledged administrative side that manages its six sites nationally and internationally and a research centre. The hospital offers facilities and services to the corporate sector, academia and industries to improve, gain and adopt new skills and technologies needed by emerging industries and healthcare research.

NUML and TDC, hereinafter will be referred as "Parties", have agreed as follows:

Article 1 General Principle

The Parties shall implement the provisions of this MOU in conformity with their organizational and relevant country laws and other obligations and will promote



cooperation in clinical services, research and commercialization in a structured fashion by developing and carrying out collaborative activities.

Article 2 Areas of Cooperation

The main areas of mutual cooperation between the Parties within the limits of their responsibility shall be as follows:-

- a. TDC will provide discounted rates on clinical laboratory and patient consultancy services.
- b. TDC may organise customised trainings for students, staff members of NUML
- c. TDC will arrange and organize medical screening camps and medical awareness sessions.
- d. TDC will provide internship, job placement to the students of NUML and also participate in NUML job fairs.
- e. TDC will provide their research centre to the students of NUML for research purposes.
- f. Other activities such as deemed appropriate by mutual consent.

Article 3 Legal Liabilities

It is understood that neither party to this MOU is the agent of the other and neither is liable for the wrongful acts or negligence of the other and this will involve no financial/legal liabilities on any party even if it is amended or modified or reviewed at any time through mutual consent of both parties in writing. Standard policies of NUML and TDC shall be applied for all mutual working relationships.

Article 4 Amendment or Modification

This MOU may be amended or modified at any time through mutual written consent of the Parties. The amendment or modification shall enter into force in the like manner as provided in Article 7 of this MOU.

Article 5 Settlement of Disputes

All differences or disputes arising from or concerning with the application or the interpretation of this MOU shall be amicably settled through mutual consultations and negotiations between the Parties in writing.



Article 6 Non-Financial Obligating Document

This MOU is neither a fiscal nor a financial obligation document. Any endeavour or transfer of anything of value involving reimbursement or contribution of funds between the parties to this MOU will be handled in accordance with applicable laws, regulations and procedures of the parties. Such endeavours will be outlined in separate document that shall be made in writing by representatives of the parties and shall be independently authorized by appropriate statutory authority. This MOU does not provide such authority.

Article 7 **Entry into Force, Duration and Termination**

This MOU shall enter into force on the date of Signatures and shall remain valid for a term of FIVE years. Either party may terminate this MOU by giving a notice of its intention to terminate this MOU six months before the expiration of the original or the renewed period. This MOU can be extended with mutual consent of the parties for an agreed upon duration. The activities undertaken during the validity of this MOU shall continue to be governed by its provision till their completion, unless the Parties agree otherwise.
