In addition to the general medical services provided at the University's Medical Inspection Room, our institution offers specific reproductive health-care services to support the well-being of our students and staff. These include:

1. Confidential Counseling and Education:

The University provides confidential consultations and education on topics related to reproduction and healthy relationships. Medical professionals and counselors are available to guide students in making informed decisions about their reproductive health.

2. Menstrual Health Support:

Sanitary products are made available across campus facilities, and menstrual health education is provided through workshops and awareness campaigns.

3. Partnership with External Health Services:

For more specialized reproductive health services, the university has established referral systems with certified external health providers.

4. Reproductive Health Awareness Campaigns:

Throughout the academic year, the university conducts educational programs, workshops, and awareness drives in collaboration with student organizations to promote safe practices, consent education and well-being.
