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




 - a. Compliance of terms & conditions regarding verification of aforesaid timeline on supporting documents (i.e., bills, invoices and receipts etc.) and equipment
 - b. All supporting documents must be kept in record as they will be monitored onsite and should be produced as and when required by Ignite

Please note that this is the provisional list of shortlisted FYPs of your institute and cannot be considered as approved. Approval of FYPs is subject to final rankings of FYPs and available budget as Ignite will only be funding top 1100 FYPs for this year based upon scrutiny and acceptance of the verified expenditure reports.


