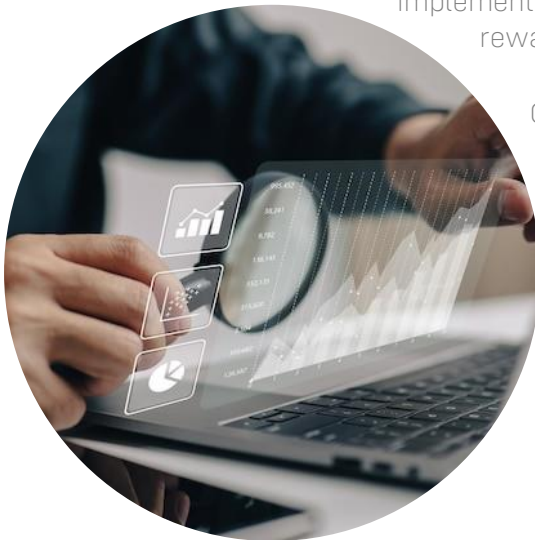

## Research Management Unit

The Research Management Unit is the cornerstone of efficient and impactful research administration. Our focus is on national and international sponsored projects, which require us to develop and refine pre- and post-award procedures, support faculty members in seamless proposal submissions, and aid Principal Investigators in budget reporting, staff hiring, and account management. In addition to these core functions, our unit actively bridges industry and academia through research steering committee meetings, fostering collaboration. Furthermore, we play a pivotal role in discussions, ensuring the alignment of research topics with broader academic standards and real-world needs for presentation in Board of Advanced Studies and Research (BASR) meetings. Lastly, our unit manages the cash incentives for research publications, which are given to the faculty members, officials, and students who contribute to NUML's research. This policy is implemented at the research management unit to motivate and reward our researchers.



Our unit is aligned with the Higher Education Commission (HEC) of Pakistan, which recognizes Offices of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORICs) as the units that support and facilitate research activities. Our unit is one of the HEC-recognized ORICs, and as such, we are subject to the HEC's performance measurement through a 'Self-Assessment Scorecard' on an annual basis.

### Funded Research Projects

The office oversees the HEC-funded National Research Program for Universities (NRPU) Project, providing awareness by sharing upcoming funding calls. Training sessions on project proposal preparation, submission, and execution are also offered. The office plays a key role in assisting with financial record-keeping. Projects in progress are monitored and reviewed throughout their duration. The "Researcher's Lounge," a dedicated co-working space, is available for all project teams engaged in research work.

## Research Theme Discussion.

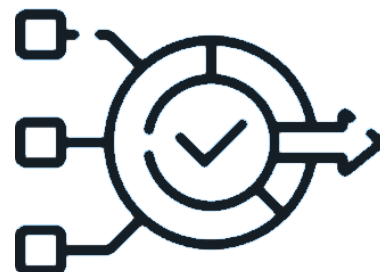
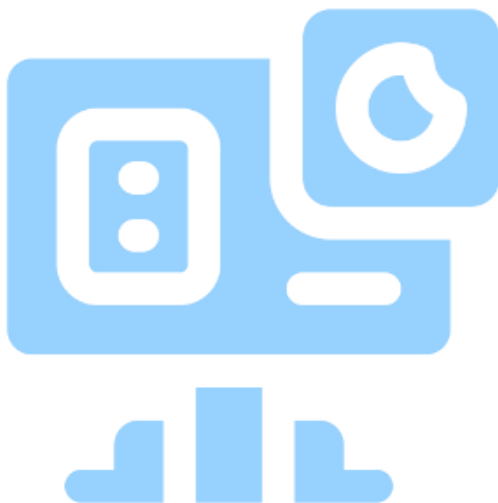

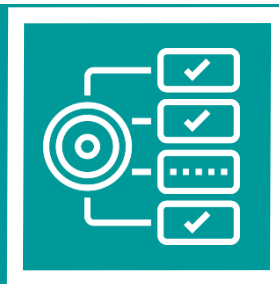
### BUSINESS INCUBATION

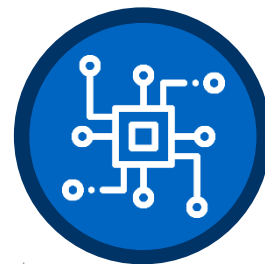

## Industry Technology Cell

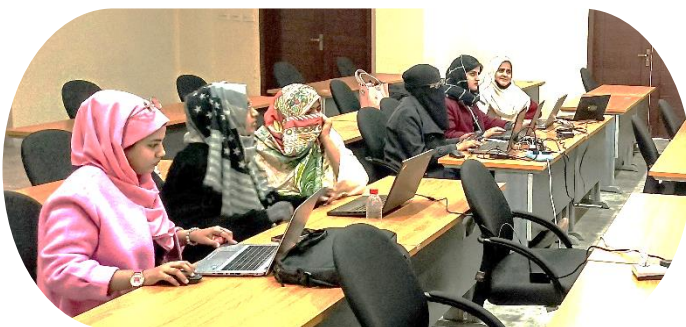

It helps the students of semester two and eight to work for a specialized tool to become "Master of One" until the completion of degree. During 2023, more than 400 students visited **IT CON** to get guidelines regarding the latest tools and technologies in the software development. They were also guided about the IT based innovative ideas, job opportunities and company startup. The students from the Computer Science and Software Engineering departments joined **IT CON** for internship in following tools.



- Mobile App wire-framing on Front-end using Figma.
- Mobile Application Development using Android (Java, Kotlin), Flutter, Xamarin.
- Back-end development using C Sharp / ASP.net on 3-tier and Model View Controller architectures based webforms along with .net Core, Web APIs, LINQ, WCF Services.
- Back-end web development using Custom PHP, Laravel, Code Ignitor.
- Back-end web development using Node JS and Django along with Python.
- Java based development for Windows and Web Applications using JSF, struts, SPRING, Hibernate, REST APIs, Web Services.
- Front-end Web development using HTML, CSS, JavaScript, Bootstrap, WebAPIs, Firebase.
- The frameworks based web development using REACT, Angular and VUE JS.

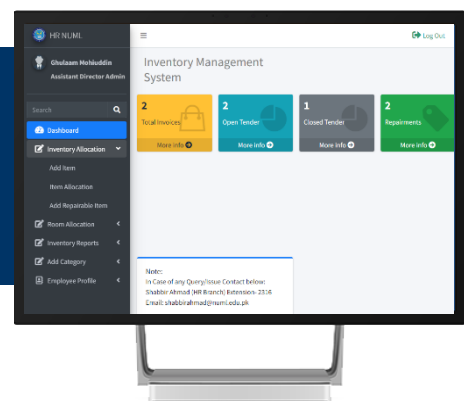
## Publication System

## Inventory Management System



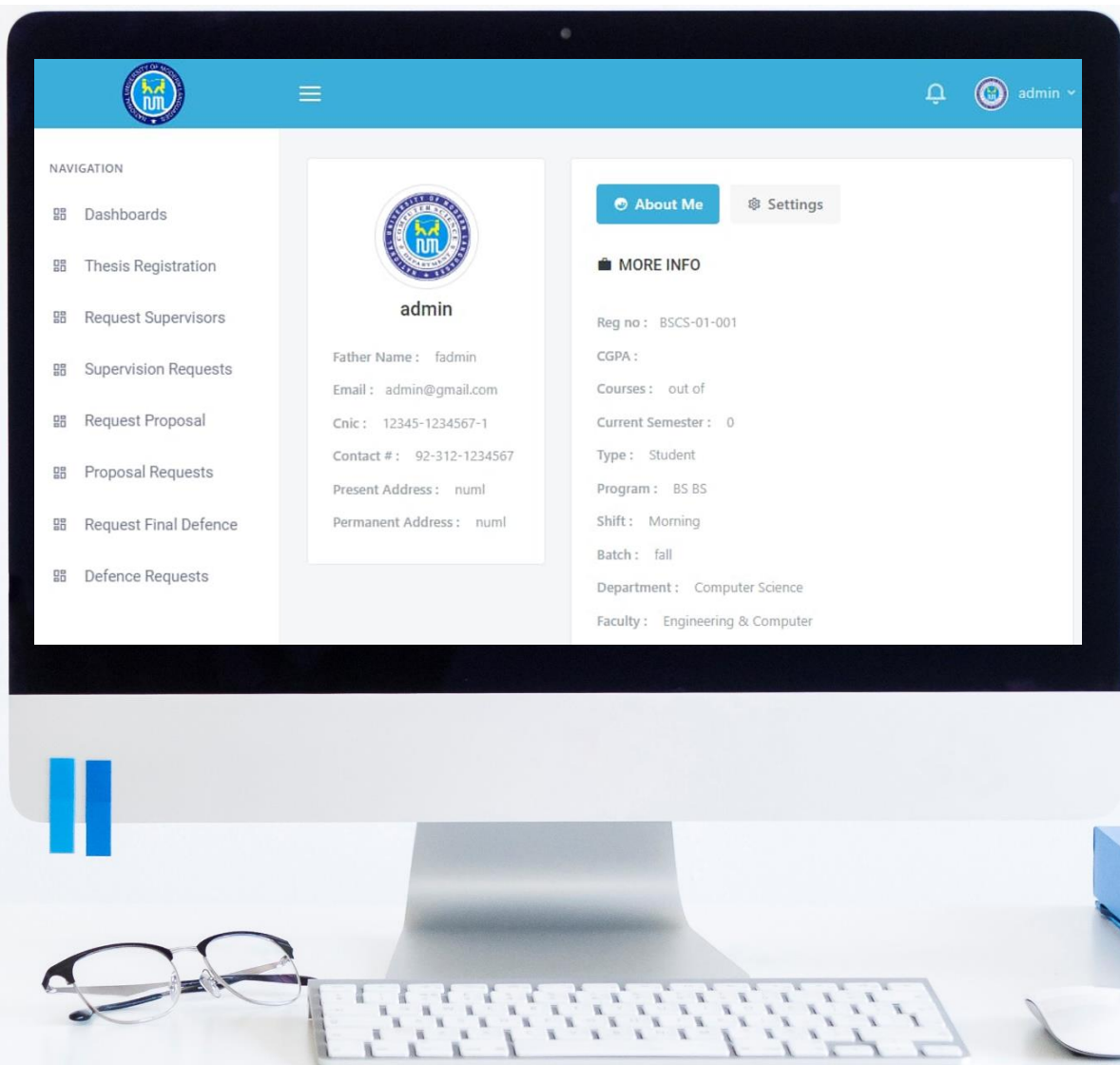

Students, supervisors, research coordinators, HoDs, Deans can manage these activities for maintaining a record of research activities and deadlines as per degree timespan for every student. The Department of Advanced Studies and Research (DASR) and the Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) can also view/process the research activities.

The articles published in NUML Journals are being validated by **Crossref**.



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NUML journals are adhering the [Budapest Open Access Initiative](#) definition of open access. Both, license and open access statements are embedded on every published research article.



[Directory of Open Access Journals \(DOAJ\)](#) is an eminent indexing agency which keeps records of open access journals of the world. Indexing in DOAJ directs towards indexing in SCOPUS and in HJRS. Moreover, Higher Education Commission (HEC) has a stringent policy to derecognize a journal that is removed from DOAJ listing.





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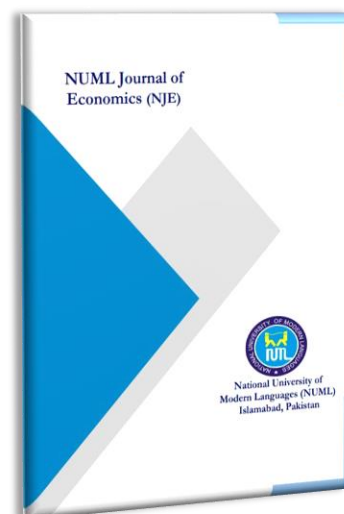

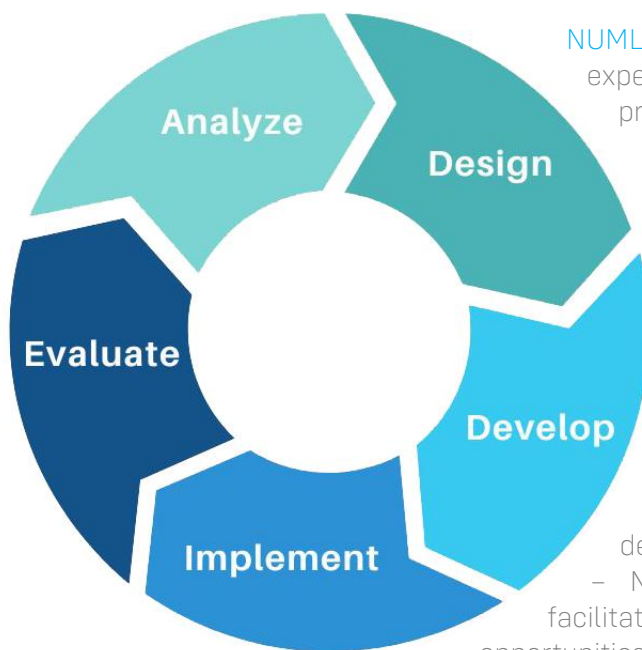

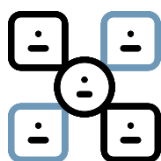
## Future Plans

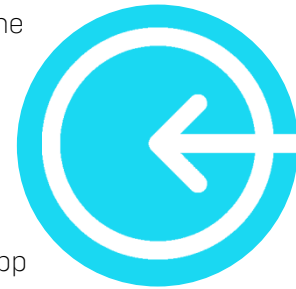

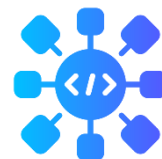

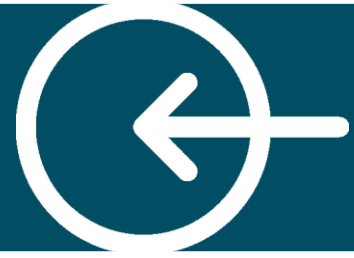
### NUML JOB FAIR 2023

## Focal Persons Training

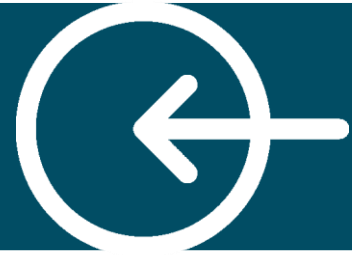
